Rules for Preliminary and Selection Round:

1. Songs must be from Bollywood movies; Hindi film songs only.
2. Selection of Winner and Runner-up will be in three stages:
 - a. Preliminary Round and Selection Round will be held on Sunday, January 17, 2016 from 10 am to 6 pm at Don Bosco Catholic Secondary School at 2nd St. Andrews Blvd. on Islington Avenue between HWY 401 and Dixon Road.
 - b. Final Round will be held on Saturday, January 30, 2016 for the three finalists in front of 6,000+ attendees at Pearson Convention Centre.
3. There will be three winners in each category.
4. Contestants should prepare one song with track and one without track.
5. Contestants must bring their track on a CD or on a USB stick at the time of registration.
6. All CD's/USB sticks must be labelled.
7. Only Sur Peti or electronic tanpura for shruti is permitted.
8. Contestants are not allowed to play any instrument.
9. Performance of each contestant should be without any accompaniment.
10. Slips/notes/lyrics for rendering the song is allowed.
11. Board of Directors of Panorama India in consultation with judges may decide to increase or decrease the number of contestants to the selection round.
12. Selection will be based on judges' marking only in the preliminary and selection rounds as per the pre-determined technical points which will be communicated to contestants ahead of the competition date.
13. Contestants should be ready with a second song if the judges require the singer to change the song or sing another song.
14. Results of contestants singing in both categories on January 17th will be announced upon completion of the preliminary rounds.
15. Three 'Finalists' will be selected in both categories for the final round, based on judges' marks.
16. Judges' decisions will be final.

Rules for Final Round:

1. Three 'Finalists' will sing one solo song with a track on Saturday, January 30, 2016 for the Republic Day Celebration.
2. Slips/notes/lyrics for rendering the song are not permitted in the final round.
3. Contestants will be marked by judges for technical points.
4. Audience will vote for the best singer through a secret ballot.
5. Each finalist will sing only one song. Time is limited to max of 5 minutes.

Audience Vote Procedure:

1. Ballots will be circulated to the audience for their voting before the first finalist sings.
2. After all finalists have sung, the ballot box will go around the audience. Folded ballots will be collected in sealed boxes by the volunteers and will be handed over to the "Counting Committee" supervised by "Idol Contest Committee of Panorama India".
3. Judges will assess the marks and submit it to the "Idol Contest Committee of Panorama India".
4. Both the audience's vote and judges' marks will be added.
5. One winner and runner-up will be declared in each category.
6. Attractive prizes will be given away to the winner and runner-up.
